

Minutes of the 2021 General Membership Virtual Meeting and Vote, June 20-27, 2021

Voting was facilitated by unique pass codes per residence, with one vote per HOA member residence, executed by on-line voting or, for members without email access, by returning unique mailed ballots.

The 30-day notice of the Annual General HOA Membership Meeting were distributed by email and mail on May 14, 2021. A total of 359 electronic and mailed ballots were distributed on Fr, June 18, 2021. A total of 71 valid votes were submitted.

The official voting results:

- 1. The Minutes of the 2020 Annual HOA Membership Meeting were approved unanimously with 19 abstentions.
- 2. The voting process, which deviated from the HOA Bylaws, was approved unanimously with 6 abstentions.
- 3. The HOA Budget of expenditures for the 2020-2021 fiscal year (April though March) was approved unanimously with 5 abstentions.
- 4. The full slate of HOA Board Officers and Members-at-Large was approved unanimously with, on average, 4 abstentions.
