### **Minutes from January 7, 2020 Social Committee meeting**

Rebecca will bring her jars for the table centerpieces and will purchase and prepare the fresh fruit. (We won't buy as much as last year as we had leftovers in 2019.) She will bring her large bowl for serving fruit. She will provide the music and will correspond with Jakob regarding the Evite announcements that we will ask him to electronically send to the neighborhood.

Becky will bring her jars for the table centerpieces, her large bowl for serving the fruit, some Valentine-related sheets for children to color, and sugar-free syrup.

Peggy, Pat and Karen will man the money and name tag table. We will move it closer to the kitchen/dining rooms so hopefully they don't get as cold as they have in the past sitting close to the outside door.

Carol K will buy a lighter stick to light the Sterno cans and a carton of 2% milk.

Carol W has already invited Roz Finch, OP Neighborhood Executive Committee, and Geoffrey Gahn, OP Police, to attend and make brief presentations. They will also bring handouts and goodies for the children. Carol will bring coffee creamer.

Cost to attend will be as last year i.e. \$5/person, children 10 and younger free.

Committee members are asked to arrive at 7 AM in order to get the dining room decorated. Doug, Carol and Joe will arrive at 6 AM in order to start the preparations for the food, coffee, juice, etc.
